<b>Second Table of the Law and Close of the Commandments</b> As the head of the family should teach them in a simple way to his household.	Completed
The Sixth Commandment   You shall not commit adultery.   What does this mean?   We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure   and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.	
The Seventh Commandment You shall not steal. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.	
The Eighth Commandment You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.	
<i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.	
The Ninth Commandment You shall not covet your neighbor's house.	
<i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.	
The Tenth Commandment You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.	
<i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.	
BIBLE VERSES:	
Matthew 18:15 If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you.	
Hebrews 13:5 Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."	

<b>Romans 13:7</b> Give to everyone what you owe him; if you owe taxes, pay taxes: if revenue, then revenue; if respect, then respect; if honor, if honor.	
<b>Proverbs 31:8</b> Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute.	
Luke 12:22 Jesus said to his disciples: "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you eat; or about your body, what you will wear."	
Psalm 37:4 Delight yourself in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart.

Leviticus 19:2 Be Holy because I, the Lord your God, am holy.

But He promises grace and every blessing to all who keep these commandments. Therefore, we should also love and trust in Him and gladly do what He commands.
